Transfer Scholarship

As a dedicated academic partner with Cecil College, Wilmington University has established a transfer scholarship in the amount of \$3,000 per academic year for selected Cecil College students. The Wilmington University Scholarship is based on the following conditions:

Conditions of Transfer Scholarship:

1. Scholarship recipients have earned an associate degree from Cecil College within the most recent academic year.
2. Scholarship recipients shall demonstrate merit based on the judgment of the Cecil College selection committee. The methods employed by the selection committee will be at the discretion of Cecil College.
3. Scholarship recipients shall be enrolled full-time at Wilmington University.
4. Scholarship awards will not exceed the amount of \$3,000 for each of the five scholarship recipients. The \$3,000 scholarship award will be split between each student's first two terms not to exceed \$1,500 in any one semester.
5. Scholarship recipients who do not earn a minimum G.P.A. of 3.0 during their first semester at Wilmington University will not be eligible for the second semester portion of the scholarship.
6. Cecil College will notify Wilmington University's Academic Partnership Office (APO) of the selected recipient(s) at least 30 days prior to the recipient(s) beginning coursework at Wilmington University.
7. There are limited funds available so this is a competitive scholarship application.
